# FRONTLINE SPRAY dosage calculation

The FRONTLINE SPRAY dose range is 3 – 6mL/kg for both cats and dogs. This equates to:

100mL Pack:	6 – 12 pumps/kg	(0.5mL/pump)
250mL Pack:	2 – 4 pumps/kg	(1.5mL/pump)

Whether the pet needs a low, medium or high dose depends on a number of factors:
